- **You will need a library card to order the books.** Please phone your closest library to get a library card. **If you are ordering from your local library:**




FULL STEAM TO CANADA: Based on a true story, Full Steam to Canada tells the tale of a British family's 1903 journey to the promise of a better, richer life on the Canadian prairies. Includes historical photos, a glossary, map and background notes.

THROUGH FLOOD & FIRE: After travelling thousands of miles, Dorothy Bolton is still getting used to her new home in Canada – and on the prairies no less. The Barr Colonists who arrived with Dorothy and her family are getting restless. Fires and floods consume homes and resources, and many promises made to them before leaving England have proven false. But Dorothy's father has always dreamed of having his own farm. So, with the help of Dorothy, her family, and a community that comes together despite their different backgrounds, the Bolton's set out to create a life for themselves on the vast prairie landscape.

TRIAL BY WINTER: In this concluding novel of the Barr Colony trilogy, the Bolton family faces a truly bitter Saskatchewan winter in an improperly built soddie that is failing to keep out the cold, so much so that they are in genuine danger
